### **GWG–Stroke Hospital Champion Roles and Responsibilities:**

- Understand the national and local impact and incidence of neurological disease and stroke
- Understand the mission of the American Stroke Association
- Understand the overall Get With The Guidelines (GWTG) program and the Stroke module (GWTG–Stroke).
- Act as a catalyst for ensuring hospitals in your market improve guideline compliance to improve patient outcomes.
  - Take leadership role in how GWTG–Stroke will be rolled out in your hospital
  - Present GWTG–Stroke to your hospital administration offices
- Take a leadership role in the GWTG–Stroke implementation plan in your hospital. This could include:
  - Presenting GWTG–Stroke information to your implementation team members
  - Presenting updates on the status of the implementation of GWTG–Stroke to your hospital administration
- Identify program improvements through local implementation.
- Monitor market progress towards completion of GWTG–Stroke Implementation Measurables.
- Encourage peers and/or hospitals to participate in GWTG–Stroke implementation
- Encourage all participating hospitals to achieve recognition for implementing GWTG–Stroke
