RURAL HEALTH CAREERS CAMP

We are looking for camp counselors to assist with activities and supervise campers in a four-day overnight camp for high school students.

RURAL HEALTH EXPERIENCE (RHE)

This three- to five-day rural immersion experience allows college students to shadow different units in a rural hospital and outlying clinics to understand multiple levels of healthcare in a rural setting.

RURAL INTERPROFESSIONAL PRECEPTORSHIP

An interprofessional group of health professions students will spend six weeks in a rural community shadowing healthcare professionals of different backgrounds, participating in weekly classroom sessions, and working as a team on a Community Service Learning Project.
