#### **SPEAKER BIOGRAPHIES**

Karla Weng, MPH, CPHQ, is a Senior Program Manager for Stratis Health, providing expertise to a variety of initiatives focused on rural providers and communities. For more than 20 years, Karla has worked on a wide variety of efforts helping rural hospitals and providers improve quality, patient safety, and population health such as development of palliative care services, implementation of quality management methods, preventing readmissions, and clinical quality efforts on topics such as heart failure and diabetes. Karla has been leading the technical assistance efforts for the Rural Health Value team since 2012 and has been the project director for the FORHP funded Rural Quality Improvement Technical Assistance program since its inception in 2015.

Jonathan Pantenburg joined Stroudwater in 2016 and brings to the firm a strong record of leadership in rural healthcare. A highly accomplished, results-driven senior executive, Jonathan has more than 15 years of progressively responsible experience advising profit, non-profit, and governmental entities through complex issues including cost reduction, acquisitions, contracts, financial analysis, and operations.
