- When primary care providers collaborate with behavioral health providers and create a blended care setting or access to treat the whole person (What Is Integrated Behavioral Health? The Academy, n.d.).

High-level Project Overview and Purpose

Overview: Provide IBH to a select number of HSHS provider practices located in Greenville, IL. For a non-traditional behavioral health program.

Purpose: To address the mental health needs within the HSHS Holy Family Health Center, located in Greenville, IL. This will also improve the IBH, provider, and patient interactions and create a more productive environment for the providers.

Objectives/Deliverables

- Obtain approval by HSHS to move project forward.
- 2) Obtain contract signatures.
- 3) Identify a psychiatrist to the Holy Family Greenville practices.
- 4) Hire a Care Manager to manage the practices.
- 5) Secure location for IBH in Greenville.
- Greenville provider education related to how the IBH program works. Create an understanding that the program is a nontraditional concept and practice, and the need for adherence to the developed IBH program.
