

# 'Healthy Hillsboro' model honored


NRHA lauds collaboration of Hillsboro Area Hospital and SIU Medicine's Population Science Department

What started as a 7-year-old Peoria girl's question on why people were being hurt in the Ukraine has evolved into a multi-state effort to ship medical supplies and ambulances to the embattled nation. This mission led Chris Manson, OSF HealthCare's Vice President



of Government Relations, to board a plane bound for Eastern Europe earlier this spring, where he eventually visited the presidential palace in Poland and then traverse a further 200 miles into the war torn nation where he was able to meet up with officials, assess the needs, and find out what happened to an AMT ambulance OSF HealthCare had sent there a few weeks earlier.

# Tracking clinical care and outcomes

ICAHN, IDPH work with Warner Hospital & Health Services to create disease registry around AFIB

As part of the 1815 grant, Warner Hospital & Health Services has partnered with ICAHN and IDPH to start the process of creating a disease registry around Atrial Fibrillation. A disease registry is a tool for tracking the clinical care and outcomes of a defined patient population.

Most disease registries are used to support care management for patients with one or more chronic diseases. This registry follows

more than 100 patients that have been in the hospital and diagnosed with AFIB. It tracks their diagnosis of hypertension or high cholesterol and what medication they are taking. It also looks at procedures they have had and if they are on blood thinner. "One of the most important things it looks at is blood pressure control," said Liz Swanson, Assistant Director, ICAHN Professional Education Services. "This registry has been an interesting tool to create and analyze. When you just focus on one disease and look at the numbers, sometimes the solution on how to move forward is clearer."

Warner will be continuing this project into the next phase of sharing data with practitioners to see what changes can be made to improve the support of the patient.
