Trauma is defined as a result of an event or set of circumstances that is experienced by an individual as physically, emotionally harmful, or life-threatening that has lasting adverse effects on the individual. Everyone who provides care in your hospital has experienced trauma, and that experience WILL impact how they interact and provide care for their patients.

Federal Rules require CAH Swing Bed programs to ensure that their staff has specific competencies addressing Trauma Informed Care and a system in place to provide the appropriate care.
